FAA Instrument Rating Flight Training Requirements

50 hours cross country flight time as Pilot In Command

40 hours of Actual or Simulated Instrument Time, including

15 hours Dual Instruction, consisting of:

- **3 hours** instrument training within the last 60 days in preparation for the practical test
- **1 IFR cross-country flight** consisting of:
 - A distance of at least 250 nm
 - An instrument approach at each airport
 - Three (3) different kinds of approaches using navigation systems
