



## MULTI ENGINE RATING ADD-ON PACKAGE

Students may choose to pay for flight training item by item or may purchase the Course Package. Multi-Engine Rating Add-On Package is ALL INCLUSIVE.

### **Flight Training:**

- 15 hours dual flight training (11 lessons)

21 hours Flight Instructor time

## **FAA Multi-Engine Add-On Rating Flight Training Requirements**

The flight training requirements for the Multi-Engine Add-On Rating assume at least an ASEL Private Pilot Certificate.

### **Flight Training in a Multi-Engine Airplane:**

- 3 hours of cross-country flight training
- 3 hours of night flight training
  - 1 cross-country flight over 100 nm total distance
  - 10 night takeoffs and landings to a full stop
- 3 hours of instrument flight training
- 3 hours flight training within the last 60 days in preparation for the practical test
